**Please Note:** Additional school charges may arise during the year. **For example: Year 10 Students may attend various camps/excursions in 2018 (essential education items). Year 10 students attend the Melbourne Familiarization Camp, which is compulsory for all students. The camp cost is yet to be confirmed, but is approximately \$320. Parents will be given sufficient notice to plan for the cost of these activities.**

**The 1:1 laptop program is implemented in Year 9. YCP-12 supports a Bring Your Own Device program where students are allowed to bring devices of their choice. For families who choose not to participate in BYOD, there is a fleet of laptops in the library that students may borrow during school hours at a cost of \$10 per term.**
