

Dear Parents and Friends of the P-4 College,

Integrity Award Winners from Week 9

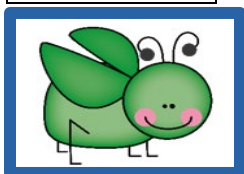
